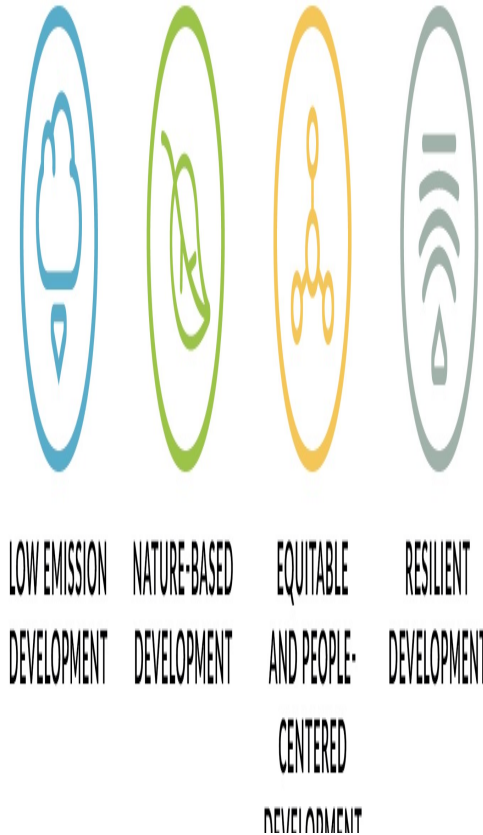

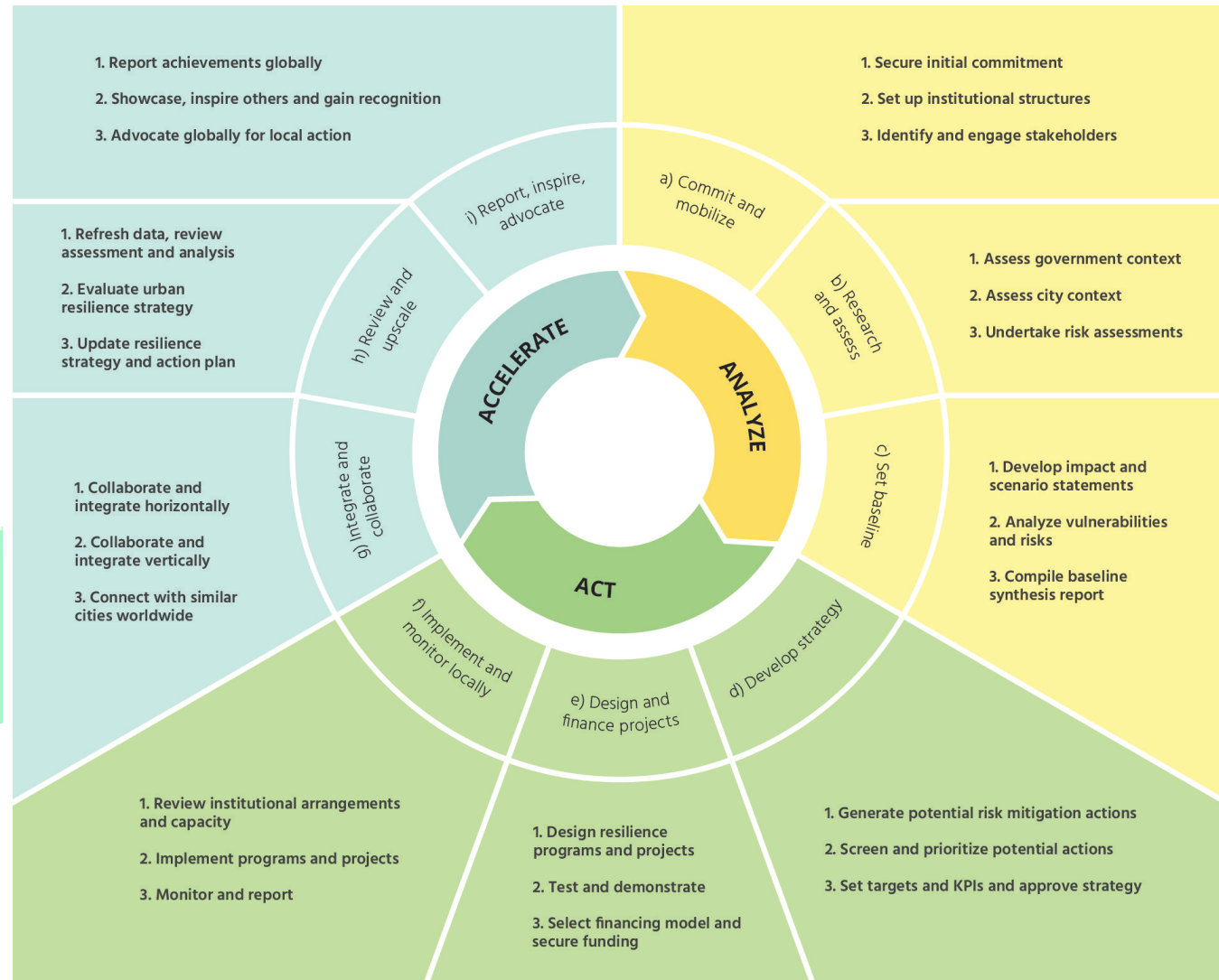

Approach: Facilitative 'Talanoa-Style Dialogue'

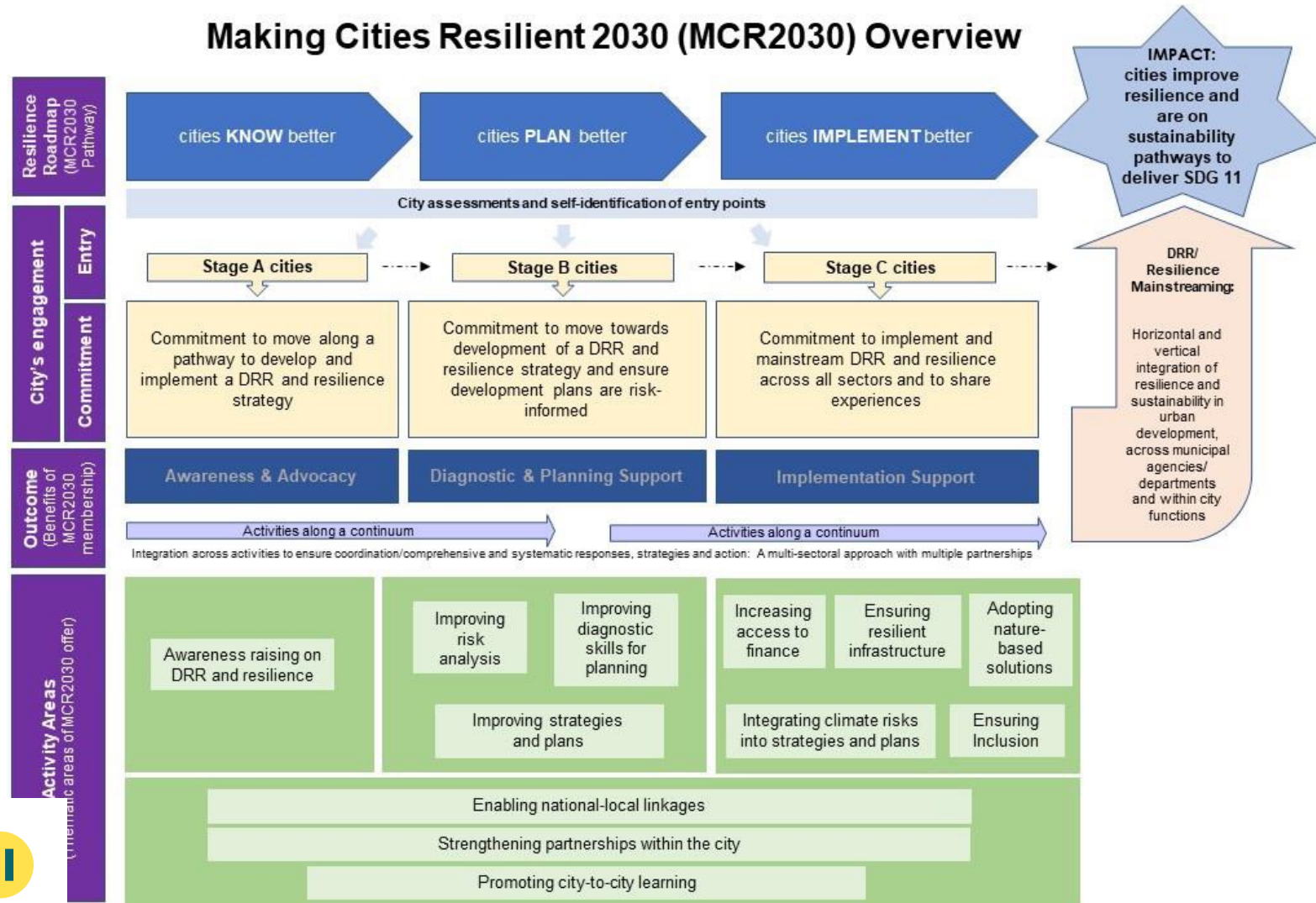
